When all seem hopeless: A valley of dry bones – Dead for a long time

Life to death is our doing – Death to life is God's – "Then you will know I am the Lord"

Up to 60% of the human adult body is water. The brain and heart are composed of 73% water, and the lungs are about 83% water. The skin contains 64% water, muscles and kidneys are 79%, and even the bones are watery: 31%. According to H.H. Mitchell, Journal of Biological Chemistry 158

Through the message of the prophet – God works, accomplishing what the human could not

Without breath there is no life – When breath enters there is life. Ps 104 27-30 All creatures look to you...remove your breath they die

When you think all is lost, your hope must turn to the Lord

Though you are not faithful, I am faithful.

One our greatest failings, the continual appreciation of what God does through our giftedness

If we say God can't or won't work in or through me, we are saying anything positive is of our doing and then who gets praised?

People who seek only the praise of a perfectly loving God don't need the praise of other broken and marginally loving humans

This is what the Spirit of God can do in and through you.

The Hebrews were not Trinitarian but ancient writings give evidence to the presence in Israel of a profound awareness of God's Spirit. Grenz 470

Ruach Roo-akh: wind and breath, breath indicates the presence of life, the life principle of living creatures. Since life found its source in God, ruach also denoted the divine power which creates and sustains life. Grenz 470

The Spirit is the divine power at work in the world. As Spirit, the transcendent God entered the natural order unpredictably. 417
