- A God who gives: Setting the people up for prosperity Faithful to those in His care
- A God who shares

Offering a way of life – Message of wisdom 1 Cor 2:6 Good News: What will make you happy, What is the reward

- A People who fear: I might not get enough of have enough Convinced each other to rebel and choose the temporal
- ➢ A People who fight -
 - Became increasingly violent to protect "their" territory "What's Good For Us"
 - No awe resulting in dishonor
 - They had moved away in attitude and action
 - Offered repeated opportunities to repent
 - How long until they turned on each other
- Are you living into the story of those who have been given the vineyard

John Lennox: Creation vs Humanism is not about facts but world view

The journey back to peace is repentance and faithfulness

- Acts 20:21 I have declared to both Jews and Greeks that they must turn to God in repentance and have faith in our Lord Jesus.
- **James 2:24** You see that a person is considered righteous by what they do and not by faith alone.
