What's in a Name - Exodus 3:1-17

I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and **I am concerned about their suffering.** ⁸ **So I have come down to rescue them** from the hand of the Egyptians **and to bring them up out of that land into a good and spacious land**, a land flowing with milk and honey.

God Responds

So I send you “with” and “in” my name to bring them out.

Moses' excuse: “Who am I” Trust me not you. Their choice to follow my means

God's Response: I Am and I will be with you

Means: the Miracles, the Lamb (Blood and Meal), the Journey

Their Responsibility

To get to the land they had to trust, obey, go (through the water **1 Cor 10:1-4**)

Like Lot's wife, their looking back stuck them and could not enjoy the deliverance

God's Responds Again Gal 4:4-5 At the right time

New means: **John 5:43** I come in his name – Lazarus' raising, so they will know

The Miracle: John 10: 37-38 3:6-10 in the name of Jesus walk;
3:13-16 By faith in the name of Jesus he is healed; Acts 4:8-12
It is by the name of Jesus that this man stands before you healed.

The Lamb, The Blood:

John 1:29 Lamb of God; **Matt 26:26f** The bread and the blood
Acts 2:38 Repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus for the forgiveness of sins

The Journey:

John 20:19-22 As the Father sent me I send you

Matt 28:18-20 ...and I will be with you to the end of the age

Phil 2:5-11 At the name of Jesus every knee shall bow and every tongue confess Jesus is Lord
