Psalm 107 Tell of your redemption: once a wanderer, God led on a straight way to a city of refuge

He satisfies your greatest need, Suffering to enlighten or destroy,
He does not leave distressed

(Viktor Frankl: I will not let them take away my choice on how I will think and live)

How Do You Respond When The Good Goes Wrong? Seek Peace

What or who has changed?

Have I wondered away from God to trust another, a dead end path?

Have others wondered away making me an object of wrath?

Consider the journey from Canaan to Egypt

Joseph's faithfulness vs his brothers' arrogance Gen 46 & 47

Leaders in fear 8-10 Fear

The time from Joseph to Moses 350 yrs. fear of losing what's mine,
being in subjection

People without a voice want to be noticed.

Want to be validated that their life matters

Jesus on earth signifies lives matter that does not mean the path they
are on leads to life

I won't force you but I will speak truth in love and die for you

Jesus let God determine who wins. For two days they thought they
won then the third

Let's distract/control them by labor, enslavement 11-22

They made their lives bitter - Not by your cussedness

We make our life bitter by worshiping things and using God

Society makes us miserable by labeling the caring as uncaring,
the loving as unloving

Ps 62 5-8 My soul rests in God, He is my refuge

The midwives feared God and ignored the king

Luke 23:34 Forgive them they don't know what they are doing

The Need, to give up the distance between you and God
