A little folly spoils something good – fly spoils

At time it is obvious

## A Great Evil:

<u>At times, a fool in high places – Upside down honor (slave on horseback princes walking</u>

Rom 1:22 they claim to be wise, they became fools The fly of rebellion spoiled God's creation Prov 12:15 The way of fools seems right to them, but the wise listen to advice.

## Christ's poverty:

The epitome of wisdom – human wisdom calls it folly
Son of man has no place to lay his head. Matt 8:20
Religious powers denied His Power
Son of Satan not the son of God
Consistently irritated by Jesus' words and way
Enters Jer. as Israel's' King left as its enemy
